The purpose of the Public Policy and Advocacy volunteer group is to keep abreast of (event, local, state, and federal) regulations and policy changes that affect the organizations' membership.

Responsibilities

- Develop a “Best Practices” guideline for vendors.
- Through consensus building create a priority list of issues pertaining to legislation, policy, regulations that affect AVA membership.
- Develop a list of potential centers of influence within the primary entities that create, implement, and enforced legislation, policy, and regulations affecting the AVA membership.
- Reach out to AVA counterpart groups in the lower 48 to prevent reinventing the wheel.
- Report to the AVA BOD quarterly.

Time Commitment

- 4 hours a month

Qualifications

- Must be an Alaska Vendors Association member in “good standing”.
